- Astro Question of the week with Don!
 - Does Earth Orbit the Sun more slowly each year?
 - Think about the mass the sun loses due to nuclear fusion (95 Earth Masses)
 - Solar winds will also cause the sun to lose mass (30 Earth masses over its lifetime)
 - What is the most distant star visible to the human eye?
 - The lowest magnitude a typical eye can see is a magnitude 6 star
 - Remember how the magnitude scale works!
 - Consider how brightness changes with distance
 - Surprisingly it is rho Cassiopeia, a magnitude 4.5 star (8200 lightyears away)
 - Try to find it yourself!
