- Spitzer Space telescope 2003-2020
 - Third dedicated IR space telescope
 - Has 3 instruments attached for different wavelengths
 - IR Array Camera
 - IR spectrograph
 - Multiband imaging photometer
 - First direct light from an exoplanet.
 - Found more pronounced bar structure in Milky Way
 - Possibly detecting some of the oldest stars
